

Background

Your research activities will be embedded within the Research Group Zoology: Biodiversity and Toxicology (Department of Biology) and the Centre for Environmental Sciences (CMK). The Centre for Environmental Sciences is a research institute of Hasselt University that opts for a wellbalanced combination and symbiosis between environmentally-related fundamental and applied research in a multidisciplinary research environment. The research group and the CMK have extensive (inter)national collaborations.

Education task

You provide high-quality education in the bachelor program of Biology, more specifically in the fields of (functional) morphology, histology, physiology, diversity and ecology of animals

Research mission

The selected candidate will contribute to the research activities of the research group Zoology: Biodiversity and Toxicology. He/she will acquire and lead research projects within the Centre of Environmental Sciences, in collaboration with scientific partners inside and outside Hasselt University. Important goals ar A1 publications in top journals, strengthening the existing research network of the group, and the supervision of PhD students. The candidate's research should be aimed at an integrative study of aquatic biodiversity, including the evolutionary processes that determine it. You are able to translate this fundamental knowledge in the development of a sustainable biodiversity policy. The candidate's research will focus on the study of biodiversity, and can be specifically focused on research fields such as (functional) molecular and morphological evolution, animal ecology or population genetics. Applied, society-relevant research is an asset (eg. research on indicator taxa, invasive exotic species)

Benefits

We will offer

- either an appointment as a lecturer in the tenure track system during 5 years. This will lead to an immediate permanent contract as a senior lecturer, if the Board of Directors favorably assesses the party involved, based on previously set public grading criteria.
- Otherwise, we will offer a fulltime appointment as a lecturer or higher, which will lead to tenure. In case of a first appointment as a member of the academic staff, the Board of Directors of the University can decide on a temporary appointment for a period up to 3 years. This will lead to a permanent contract if the Board of Directors favorably assesses the party involved.

Selection process

Preselection based on CV. Selected candidates are interviewed and assessed on a test lesson / presentation.
