WHAT FOR IS THE PROGRAMME DESIGNED?

- To improve the transparency and the recognition of the studies carried out abroad (development of credit recognition systems).
- To allow students to benefit of language diversity through the learning of European/Mediterranean languages in the host countries
- “To save” students from the most vulnerable population groups (refugees, displaced populations, disabled foreign students, economically disadvantaged groups and indigenous populations etc...)

1.2 TARGET GROUPS

1. Students (undergraduate, postgraduate, Masters and doctoral students) and academic staff (teachers and/or researchers) belonging to any of the partner institutions (minimum participation of this group 50% and at least 70% of mobility grants for Third Countries)
2. Nationals from any of the participant countries who belong to non-partner institutions (whenever they are studying or did already graduate).
3. National from the participant countries who are in a vulnerable situation (refugees, disabled students etc..)
