The Master's in Human Resources Management and Management program offers complete training to those who wish to carry out and develop their professional activity and to initiate research in the area of Human Resources, such as managers or technicians of human resources in any company or organization private or public; in consulting services, such as consultants or technicians in selection, training, personnel management or communication. Also, as area coordinators in departments of personnel administration, labor, etc.

More specifically, through the development of the master's degree the student will acquire the following competences: ability to plan, organize and make decisions in the field of human resource management; analyze and synthesize variables and problems that affect the direction and management of people; solving problems in the direction and management of human resources; management of social and interpersonal skills applied to the organizational field; work in teams, coordinate and lead them in the context of organizations; ethical commitment at work as a professional in the direction and management of human resources; critical reasoning in the work in front of the dilemmas and challenges of the direction and management of human resources; professionalism and motivation for quality in the processes and results of the direction and management of people; adaptation to new situations, initiative and entrepreneurial spirit regarding the challenges of the leadership and management of human resources; autonomous learning and continuous improvement in professional knowledge and skills related to the direction and management of people.
