

## **FINE ARTS FACULTY CONTINGENCY PLAN FOR THE PREVENTION OF CORONAVIRUS INFECTION**

Following the instructions of the COVID-19 Monitoring Commission of the University of Murcia, the following measures are adopted, the temporal scope of which will be marked by the rector's resolutions which, in turn, will be determined by the regional and state guidelines.

Official teachings:

- A plan of alternative activities will be established for each subject to the face-to-face classes.
- Students will be provided with learning materials and resources autonomous: bibliography, scripts and summaries of topics with PowerPoint presentations or similar.
- Evaluable practical activities will be designed as an alternative to practice in the classroom.
- Virtual tutoring will be maintained and an extensive schedule of consultations.
- It is advisable to use the tools of the Aula Virtual - chats, forums, videoconference - to establish the relationship with students and to announce possible group activities.
- It is advisable to consider recording classes or teaching in streaming through the virtual classroom videoconference.

- All the curricular and extracurricular practices of the students of the UMU is suspended. Also, all practices are suspended of organizations, companies and institutions that are carried out in our University. However, as long as the internship centre ensure the possibility of developing the training activities of in a non-presential way, it will be possible to continue with the practices.

Complementary activities to classroom teaching:

- The activities that were planned for the coming weeks will be rescheduled; specifically, talks, conferences, seminars that required people to travel by public transport or from other locations.
- Possible practices planned with students will be cancelled or delayed.
- Scheduled talks at institutes and centres are cancelled or delayed of high school.
- Alternative methods of theoretical and practical evaluation of those mobility students (Erasmus, Sicue, etc.) who decide suspend your stay outside the UMU.

The Vice-rectorate of Studies has announced that it is studying possible changes in the academic calendar that would affect the second school year four-month period, to the announcement of exams and to the defense of TF (final work).

## **FACILITIES**

The Rector of the University of Murcia has signed a binding resolution compliance, the third point of which indicates:

By way of derogation from the previous point, and without prejudice to general recommendation of the health authorities to restrict mobility, as the declaration of Alarm Status allows the "travel to the place of work to perform (the) service work, professional or business", members of the community university (WORKERS) will be able to access to the buildings voluntarily, using their college cards, to carry out essential tasks related to teaching, the research, management or administration.

At no time should students or family members have access to the facilities college girls. It is reiterated that only male and female workers can access to carry out an indispensable task.
