

GUIDELINES FOR THE PRESENTATION OF PROPOSALS

Guidelines for the presentation of oral communications

- 1.** Oral communications will be presented in the sessions allotted. We invite you to prepare a Blitz presentation.
- 2.** Each speaker will be allocated 6 minutes for oral presentation, followed by a 3-minute slot for discussion (broadly equating to ~20 slides at 20 seconds of commentary per slide).
- 3.** Presentations can be delivered either in Spanish or English.
- 4.** The structure of proposals must be the following:
 - TITLE and AUTHOR(S). Author's name and affiliation (Department and University or Research Center, if applicable) should be specified.
 - INTRODUCTION AND AIMS
 - MATERIALS AND METHODOLOGY
 - RESULTS (already obtained and/or foreseeable)
 - DISCUSSION AND CONCLUSIONS
